- Revenue of \$102.1M, up 25% year-over-year
- Shipped 195MW (AC) or 225MW (DC), up 48% year-over-year
- Non-GAAP gross margin of 32.7%
- Non-GAAP operating income of \$3.0 million
- Non-GAAP net income of \$2.8 million
- Non-GAAP diluted earnings per share of \$0.06

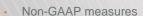
